INSTRUCTOR COST:

Our 2 specialist instructors are **free**

POOL COST: Entry to the pool is **free**

(Thanks to Kyogle Council).

BUS COST: **\$20 per student or \$30 per family.**

This covers about 50% of the cost - the school will use global funds to pay the balance.

Because we are a small school, we are allowed to take Kinder, Year 1 and our good swimmers with us and provide lessons for everyone as long as we have enough extra helpers.
