Students and staff have been working very hard to meet the deadline of this Friday for all projects to be ready for submission this Friday.

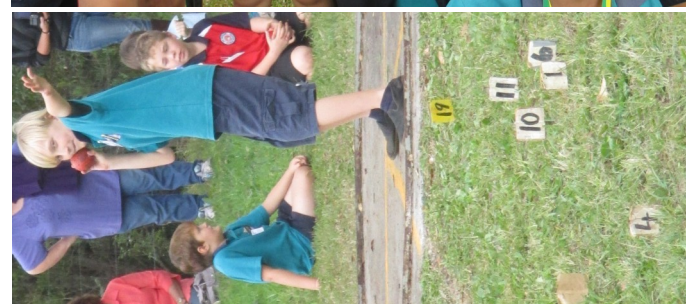
