DISTRICT ATHLETICS: ANOTHER GREAT DAY !!

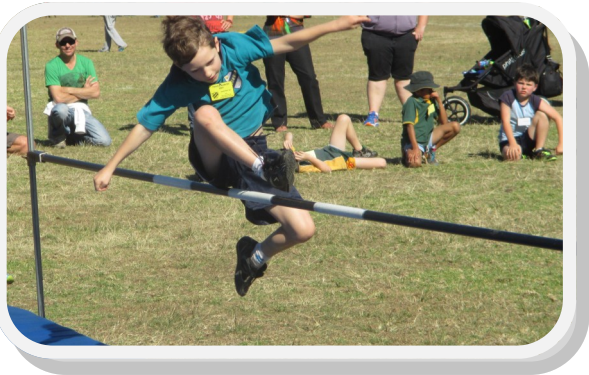
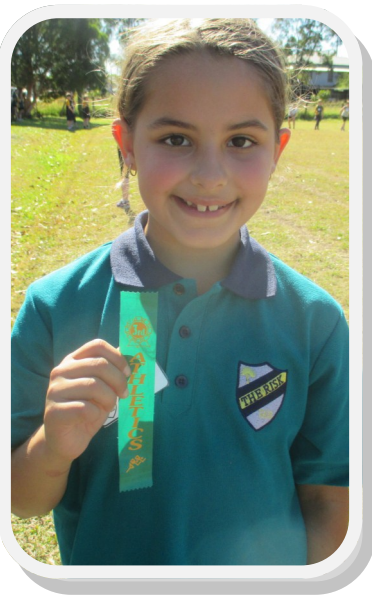
