We will do our own lesson next week then Kel comes back for 1 more session on 3rd March



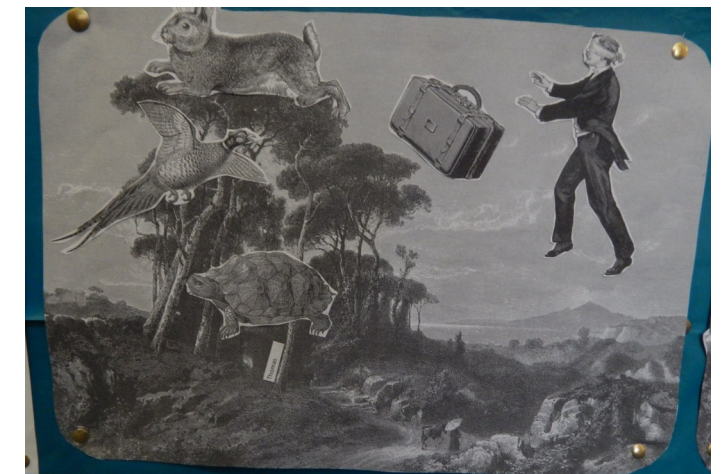
