QUEENSLAND EXCURSION NEWS

A reminder to PRIMARY CLASS families that the \$100 deposit is due by this Friday. Only 9 and a half weeks till we go!

BRONZE MORNING TEA THIS FRIDAY

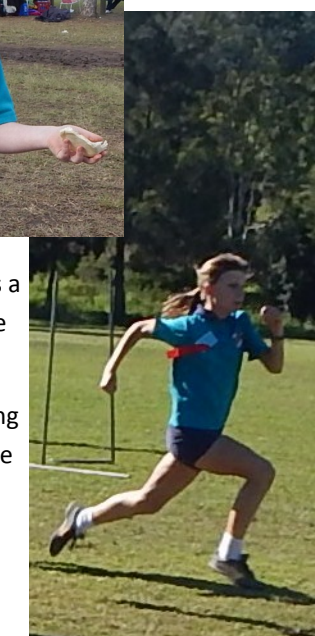
Students who have been awarded a Bronze certificate through our school merit system are invited to attend a free morning tea with the Principal this Friday in the Library at 11.10am.
