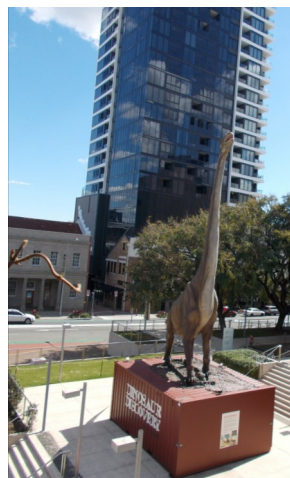

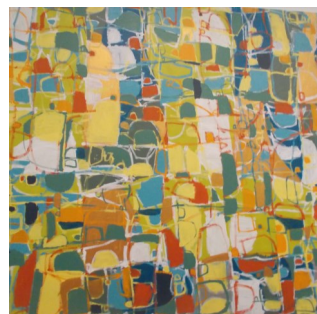
QUEENSLAND EXCURSION EXCITEMENT
