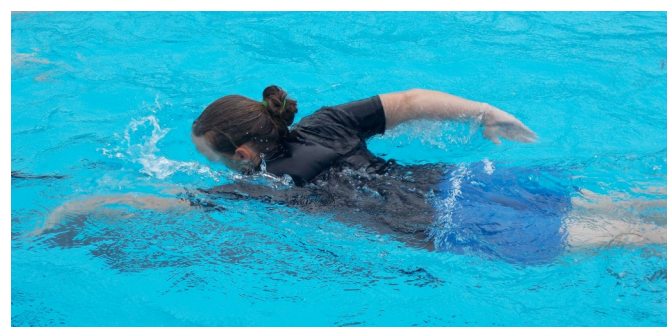


INTENSIVE SWIMMING

IT'S ON AGAIN !!! THE INTER-SCHOOL CRICKET COMPETITION



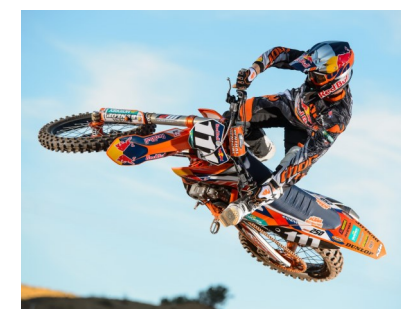
