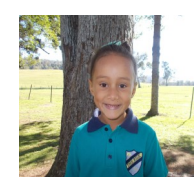


PUBLIC SPEAKING

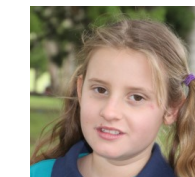

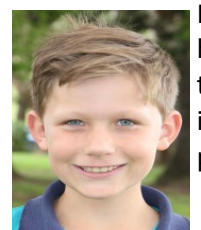
