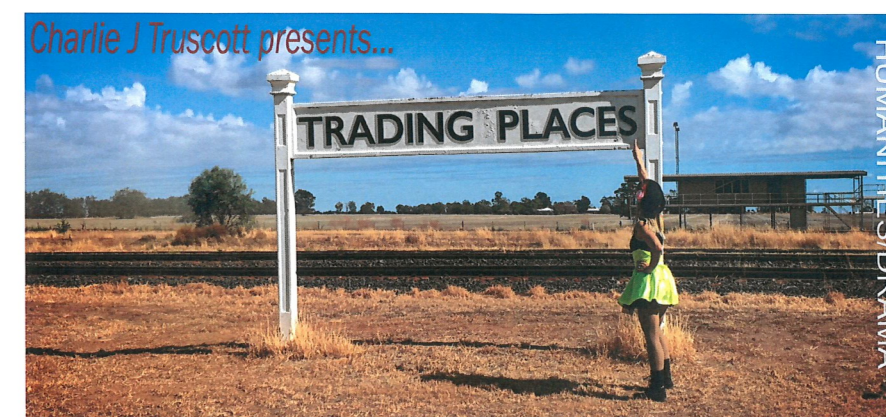

She then went on to pursue Performance Studies at University before "running away" to join circus Monoxide in 2009. 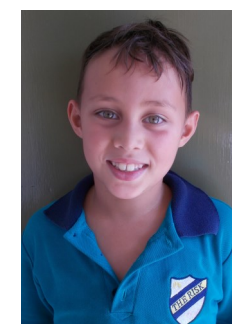
TRADING PLACES - What's in a postcode?
