## THE RISK VISITS AFTERLEE FOR LIFE EDUCATION

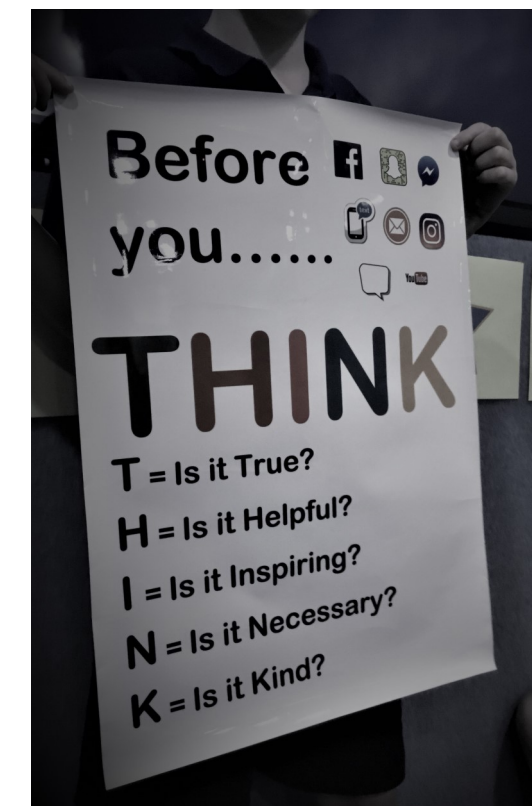
