Thank you to everyone who sent back an expression of interest for the opportunity to participate in the Lismore Conservatorium of Music program - "Music in Schools". The instruments available for lessons are violin, piano, guitar and ukulele. **Please select only these instruments.** Lessons are 10 x 30 minutes lessons - \$320 or 10 x 30 minute shared lessons - \$160. The program will go ahead if enough people register. The Lismore Conservatorium of music is a registered activity provider for the NSW government creative kid's voucher. Parents, guardians and carers can apply for a voucher with a value of up to \$100 per calendar year for each student aged 4.5 to 18 years old enrolled in school.

The voucher may be used with a registered activity provider for registration, participation and tuition costs for creative arts, speech, drama, dance, digital design, coding, and music lessons and activities. The voucher can be used at any time during the calendar year it was issued.

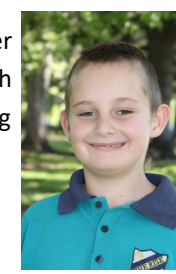

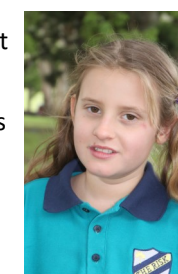
