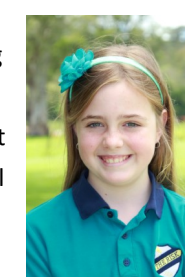

DANCE CONCERT IN KYOGLE

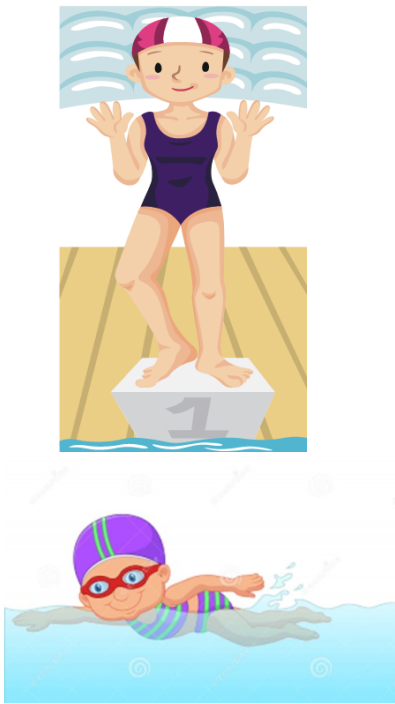
